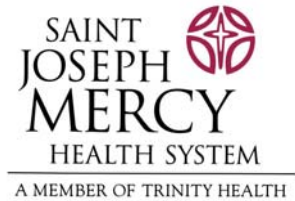


## **Saint Joseph Mercy Health System** *Fact Sheet*



### **Saint Joseph Mercy Health System**

- For decades, Saint Joseph Mercy Health System (SJMHS), a member of Trinity Health, has been at the forefront of combining clinical excellence with compassionate care to improve the health of communities across Michigan.
- The health system includes St. Joseph Mercy Hospital in Ann Arbor, Saint Joseph Mercy Saline Hospital, Saint Joseph Mercy Livingston Hospital in Howell, and 18 outpatient facilities.
- Major clinical services include cancer, cardiovascular, orthopedics, neurosciences, emergency medicine, women's and children's health, senior health, and a full range of advanced surgical services.
- All SJMHS hospitals feature private patient rooms for personalized, individual care and patient and family comfort.
- Saint Joseph Mercy Health System is a ministry organization of Trinity Health, the fourth largest Catholic health system in the United States.

### **St. Joseph Mercy Hospital**

- St. Joseph Mercy Hospital (SJM) is a not-for-profit, academic, teaching and tertiary care hospital licensed for 565 beds on a 341-acre campus in Ann Arbor, Mich.
- St. Joseph Mercy Hospital's oncology program is designated by the National Cancer Institute as a Clinical Community Oncology Program, one of only 50 programs in the United States.
- Consistently ranked in the top 100 hospitals for orthopedic procedures and cardiovascular care.
- Home to the renowned Michigan Heart & Vascular Institute, one of the top three cardiovascular programs in the state of Michigan based on volume.
- Home to the Ellen Thompson Women's Health Center which offers a full array of services for women, children and families
- SJMH's campus is the home of Huron Woods Residential Home for patients with Alzheimer's and dementia as well as The Village at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, an assisted and independent living center for seniors.
- St. Joseph Mercy Hospital trains 150 residents a year in internal medicine, general surgery, obstetrics and gynecology, emergency medicine and family practice.

### **Saint Joseph Mercy Livingston Hospital**

- Saint Joseph Mercy Livingston Hospital (SJMLH) is licensed for 136 beds in Howell, Mich., and is Livingston County's only full-service hospital.
- Key clinical services include a full service emergency department, seeing approximately 35,000 visits a year; obstetrics; joint replacement and rehabilitation; surgery; critical care; diagnostics and outpatient care.
- An extension of the Livingston hospital, Saint Joseph Mercy Woodland Health Center is a 96,000 square-foot state-of-the-art outpatient facility in Brighton, Mich., which houses urgent care, laboratory, imaging and physician offices.
- The 30,000-square-foot Saint Joseph Mercy Woodland Cancer Center, the first and only comprehensive cancer center in Livingston County, opened in May 2006 and boasts the only linear accelerator in the county for the treatment of tumors

## **Saint Joseph Mercy Saline Hospital**

- Saint Joseph Mercy Saline Hospital (SJMSH) is a licensed 82-bed facility in Saline, Mich., with an award-winning 24-hour emergency department, seeing approximately 17,500 ER visits a year.
- Key clinical services include emergency, outpatient surgery, cardiac rehabilitation, radiology services, and an Acute Care for Elders (ACE) unit specializing in geriatric care.
- The emergency department has ranked among the highest in the country for patient satisfaction according to a national patient satisfaction survey group.
- In 2007, Solucient named SJMSH one of the nation's 100 Top Hospitals in the small community hospital category. SJMHS was only one of 20 hospitals listed in this category.

## **Modern Milestones**

**1994** Opened the Michigan Heart & Vascular Institute on the campus of St. Joseph Mercy Hospital.

**1995** Catherine McAuley Health System entered a two-year association with Providence to become Mission Health.

**1997** At the end of the two-year association, Catherine McAuley Health System became Saint Joseph Mercy Health System.

**1998** A new health center in Canton, called Saint Joseph Mercy Canton Health Center, opened.

## **Today. . .**

**2000** Mercy Health Services, the parent organization of Saint Joseph Mercy Health System, and Holy Cross Health System together became Trinity Health.

**2001** Saint Joseph Mercy Woodland Health Center opened in Brighton.

**2001** The Village at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital and The Village at Woodland Health Center opened to provide independent and assisted living services to seniors.

**2002** Saline Community Hospital became Saint Joseph Mercy Saline Hospital and McPherson Hospital became Saint Joseph Mercy Livingston Hospital. The Ellen Thompson Women's Health Center opened on the campus of St. Joseph Mercy Hospital.

**2004** Imaging Center and Family Birth Center at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital opened offering more direct access to interventional services (endoscopy, cardiac imaging, MRI, CT Scan and other radiology) and obstetric services.

**2004** The Center for Digestive Care opened on the campus of St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, Ann Arbor.

**2006** Cancer Center opened at Saint Joseph Mercy Woodland Health Center, Brighton.

**2006** New Surgery Pavilion opened at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, Ann Arbor.

**2007** CyberKnife®, a revolutionary way to treat cancer throughout the body began operating at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, Ann Arbor.

**2007** First of two new patient towers to open at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, Ann Arbor.

**2010** Second patient tower to be completed at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, Ann Arbor.

**2011** New Patient Towers, a new entryway and chapel complete at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, Ann Arbor in time for it's centennial celebration.
