Pediatric Emergency

Children rarely seem to get sick or injured during regular office hours. Pediatric Emergency provides medical care for youngsters when their doctor is not available – especially in the evening, on weekends and on holidays. Injured or ill children are also referred directly from the physician's office or urgent care for further assessment or treatment when they are very ill or need immediate attention.

Board-certified pediatricians staff pediatric Emergency, nurses and technicians who have been specially trained in the care of illnesses and injuries of infants, children and adolescents up to 19 years old. Pediatric Emergency at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital works closely with pediatricians in the community. After treatment in Pediatric Emergency, children are referred back to their personal physicians for follow-up and routine care.

Pediatric Inpatient Care

Inpatient care is provided by the Pediatric Hospitalists from the Newborn Associates Program: Anne Boyd, MD, Mary Jane Callegari, MD, Jodi Fichera, MD, Bradley Judge, MD, Brian Kennedy, MD, Amy Mosher, MD, Amy Shah, MD, Errol Soskolne, MD, Lisa Turner, MD, Anne VandenBelt, MD and Eric Wheatley, MD.

Our 12-bed pediatric unit, staffed by pediatric nurses, cares for patients from newborn to 18 years old and focuses on providing family-centered care. All patient rooms are private and equipped with a bathroom and shower in the new East Tower. Each room is 300 square feet and provides a family zone dedicated for family and visitors that includes computer access. The family zone includes a comfortable recliner, a chair that converts into a bed to accommodate a parent or caregiver, and wireless Internet service. We encourage parents to stay 24-hours-a-day with their child during hospitalization. Each room has a patient media system with a 32-inch flat screen television for education and entertainment. Video games and DVD players are available upon request, and there's a lending library of age-appropriate movies. There's even a playroom filled with toys for all, a large fish tank and pet therapy.

A dedicated pediatric pharmacist, specialized psychiatrists and pediatric social work staff meet the needs of patients on the pediatric unit and the NICU. Many pediatric sub-specialists see patients at St. Joe's. See the list on the back of this flyer.

Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU)

Five board-certified neonatologists, pediatricians, other subspecialty physicians and neonatal nurse practitioners provide specialized medical services for ill newborns. In addition to registered nurses and respiratory therapists experienced in the care of neonates, neonatal nutritionists, physical therapists, pharmacists, lactation consultants, social workers and pastoral care providers contribute to the comprehensive, family-centered care provided in the NICU. Following discharge home from the NICU, we continue to monitor the progress of our NICU 'graduates' through our multidisciplinary developmental assessment clinic.

Diverse services provided by the NICU at SJMH include:

- Delivery attendance and stabilization of newborns
- Comprehensive Neonatal Transport team
- Evaluation and developmentally appropriate medical support of the ill neonate with:
 - Respiratory disease (including treatment with nasal CPAP, conventional ventilator support, high frequency ventilation, inhaled nitric oxide); flexible bronchoscopy is also available
 - Sepsis/infection
 - Neurologic abnormalities (continuous bedside EEG monitoring is available)
 - Renal abnormalities
 - Hematologic abnormalities

- Genetic abnormalities and congenital anomalies
- Ophthalmologic abnormalities; laser retinal surgery is available for retinopathy of prematurity
- Limited cardiac surgical services (e.g. patent ductus arteriosus ligations); for other congenital heart disease diagnosis, initial care and stabilization is provided
- Select gastrointestinal tract malformations needing pediatric surgical services (e.g. omphaloceles, imperforate anus, intestinal atresias, inguinal hernia repair)
 - National simulation center for physician and nursing education
 - Extensive family involvement, support, and education
 - Active family advisory board
 - Extensive parental instruction prior to discharge
 - Seamless transfer of care of infants to their primary care provider at the time of discharge
 - Prenatal consults for families expecting a baby anticipated to need NICU services after delivery
 - Consults may occur while mother is an inpatient or on an outpatient basis
