The volunteer physicians, nurses and staff of the Peoples' Clinic are committed to providing quality health care services, ensuring that everyone can live a healthier and more productive life.

Who qualifies:

- Residents of St. Clair County (must show proof)
- Persons 18 through 64 years of age
- Low-Income Individuals
- Persons without Health Insurance; some Medicaid and state medical programs are accepted.

### *Some Services Not Provided by Peoples' Clinic*

- Pregnancy care
- Money for surgery, dental care, or any medical expense
- Immunizations
- Prescribing of any narcotics or drugs with the potential for misuse
- Emergency care

- Disability, DHS or workers' compensation evaluation or paperwork
- Back to work slips for work missed before clinic visit or not ordered by clinic doctor
- Call-in service for prescription refills
- Filling of prescriptions without first being seen at the clinic, or prescription refills that were first filled at another source.
